

Forrest County Clean Up Day

Saturday, October 28, 2017

Collection sites will be available throughout the county for residents to dispose of used tires, electronic waste (computers, television monitors), yard waste, scrap metal and white goods, including discarded appliances. County personnel will be on hand to assist with unloading. This event is sponsored by the Forrest County Board of Supervisors and through a Solid Waste Assistance Grant from the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ).
